## University Tribute

Concordia University, Texas visualized a special commemoration for its upcoming centennial anniversary - a replication of an original cornerstone on its campus to serve as a reminder for key funders and stakeholders. Because injection molding was too costly for a piece like this, and due to likely multiple revisions it would take to produce the desired end product, the university turned to 3D printing.

## **Our Solution**

After a few iterations and presentations of samples to the Concordia team, the right color and texture was replicated with a specialty, stone-like, European PLA filament.

By creating a flat surface in the center of the cornerstone, we were able to utilize our partner pad printing company to complete the pad print without losing adhesion.
